Lectionary List

The best place to start preparing for your children's sermon is to read the appropriate Gospel text for your scheduled Sunday. To find out what your text is, you can use the document at this website:

There are also several sermon index that you can use if you want to find a sermon for a week other than the most recent upcoming one. It is not dated, so you'll need to know the gospel text for your Sunday when searching for an upcoming week.

Spark Curriculum

This is the new Sunday school curriculum for children ages 2 – 6th grade. Each week, the children participate in a large group opening that sets the stage for the lesson. Also, each week there is a family take-home sheet that each student gets during SS. These two resources have several questions and activities that might help you brainstorm your children's sermon.
